Libby is a free app where you can enjoy ebooks, digital audiobooks, and magazines from your public library. You can stream titles with Wi-Fi or mobile data, or download them for offline use and read anytime, anywhere.

- Easy account management - see your checkouts, place holds, renew items.
- Scan your library barcode from your phone.
- See the nearest CPRL location to you anytime (allow location settings for this feature).

- Scan ISBNs to see if the library has a copy.
- Browse reading lists and search the catalog.
- Link your child's library card.
